EXAMPLE 2

Hazard Classification: Carcinogenicity, Category 1A

Most important symptoms and effects, both acute and delayed

- > May cause irritation of the respiratory tract.
- > Repeated and/or prolonged skin contact may cause irritation.

LACKING

> May cause eye irritation.

No mention of the only Significant Delayed Hazard – "May cause cancer"

Hazard pictograms (GHS-US)



Signal Word: (GHS-US) : Danger

Hazard Statements (GHS-US) : H350 - May cause cancer (inhalation)

4.2 Most important symptoms and effects, both acute and delayed

Symptoms/injuries after inhalation : May cause irritation of the respiratory tract.

Symptoms/injuries skin contact : Repeated and/or prolonged skin contact may cause irritation.

Symptoms/injuries after eye : May cause eye irritation

contact
