

## EXAMPLE 2

**Hazard Classification: Carcinogenicity, Category 1A**

**Most important symptoms and effects, both acute and delayed**

- May cause irritation of the respiratory tract.
- Repeated and/or prolonged skin contact may cause irritation.
- May cause eye irritation.

**LACKING**

*No mention of the only Significant Delayed Hazard – “May cause cancer”*

Hazard pictograms (GHS-US)



Signal Word: (GHS-US) : Danger

Hazard Statements (GHS-US) : H350 - May cause cancer (inhalation)

### EXAMPLE 2: SDS – SECTION 4

#### 4.2 Most important symptoms and effects, both acute and delayed

Symptoms/injuries after inhalation : May cause irritation of the respiratory tract.

Symptoms/injuries skin contact : Repeated and/or prolonged skin contact may cause irritation.

Symptoms/injuries after eye contact : May cause eye irritation
